To the teacher:

I know many of you will be discussing the Olympics with your students as the Games progress. I thought it would be fun to have Itchy involved. Most of the activities are pretty straightforward. You will need to read the instructions to them and make sure they understand the task. It may be helpful to go over the pictures with the students before setting them to work. On the 'skating' page, discuss how skaters carefully make figure 8's with their skates and read the words to the students. On the 'curling' page, read the words with the students. If they know the sounds, perhaps they can identify the beginning sound for you first (except ice).

Photocopy the pages double sided (the order doesn't matter), fold in half and staple down the center to form a booklet.

As an additional activity, say the name of each sport and have the children clap the syllables.
